

POLICY ON LIBRARY CARDS

To obtain a Library card, eligible individuals must provide:

A valid government-issued photo ID showing the name, current mailing address, and date of birth. A physical address must be provided if the mailing address is a P.O. Box. Additional contact information including a phone number and/or an email address, should be provided as well.

Minors age 12 through 17 may obtain a teen library card by presenting a current school ID card or government-issued photo ID. Address verification may be required.

Minors age 5 and up may obtain a juvenile library card when accompanied by one parent. The accompanying parent must present a valid library card in good standing. The adult will take full financial responsibility for all materials borrowed on the minor(s) accounts.

Library cards will be valid for five (5) years from the date of issue. The card may be renewed at five (5) year intervals, provided the holder maintains California residency. Lost cards may be replaced for a replacement fee.
