

- **Children (ages 0–12):** Pick up a paper reading log at the library starting June 13. Each week, readers who meet their goal will receive a free book and a weekly prize (while supplies last), thanks to our generous local businesses.
- **Teens:** Play a book-themed game of Bingo on the Beanstack app.
- **Adults:** Track your reading with a paper bingo card (available at the library) or use Beanstack.

Every reader earns one weekly ticket for the Grand Prize Drawing. You might win tickets to see the Coachella Valley Firebirds play at Acrisure Arena!
